Job Description

The incumbent is recognized and perceived by peers, competitors, and client personnel as an experienced professional. The Senior Consultant is responsible for the timely and accurate completion of projects that are of average complexity or the completion of portions of projects that are of above average complexity. The duties of this position include, but are not limited to:

- Project Management and prosecution of work including the effective use of NewGen technical and support resources
- Performance of basic to advanced financial analysis and preparation of financial models with user-friendly dashboards to improve flexibility in decision making addressing our client's most challenging problems
- Maintains routine contact with the client and with subcontractors or with the prime contractor during all phases of the project
